


Homework Grid -Autumn 1

<p><u>History/DT</u> As we're learning all about Ancient Greece, research some traditional Greek food, and maybe try and taste some! Did you like it? What did you like the best and why?</p> 	<p><u>History</u> The Olympics started in Ancient Greece many years ago and they were so amazing that we continue to have them today. Can you create your own fact file about the Ancient Greek Olympics?</p> 	<p><u>Art</u> In art, we are looking at pottery. Can you sketch some unique pottery from in your home? It could be a plate, vase, glass, mug. Can you label it? Make sure you ask an adult before handling any special items.</p> 
<p><u>Science</u> We are learning about the different 'states of matter' in our science lessons this term. Can you draw a poster showing everything you have learnt so far about the states of matter? One of these substances is ooblek. Have a go at using your knowledge to create a fact file about everything you have learnt so far. This could be tea-stained and rolled to look like a Torah! Can you add some Hebrew writing to your work?</p> 
<p><u>English</u> In English, we are looking at Athena- The Story of a Goddess. Imagine you are Athena and write a diary entry from her point of view when she triumphed over Poseidon to win the city of Athens. What did she do? How did she manage to win? How did she feel?</p> 	<p><u>English</u> We are also going to be looking at 'Theseus and the Minotaur'. The Minotaur was a monster that was half human and half bull. Can you write a small paragraph describing the Minotaur?
