How have the Ancient Greeks influenced the Romans?

The Ancient Greeks can be considered one of the most influential societies. They influenced:

- Architecture
- Social practices

How have Socrates and Aristotle's philosophies affected us?

Socrates was the first major Greek philosopher. He came up with the Socratic Method. He studied problems through a question and answer technique. Socrates got the Greeks to start thinking hard about morals, good and evil, and how their society should work. Aristotle studied plants, animals and rocks. He carried out experiments to find out about the world we live in. Modern scientists do the same kind of thing.

What are the similarities and differences in democracy between Ancient Greece and how we live now?

Ancient Greece:

Only men could vote, decision makers were chosen randomly, they did not have police and a group of 500 jurors decide punishments.

Now:

All citizens over 18 can vote, MPs are voted for, each elected party can stay in power for 4 years.
