

## **Minor First Aid Procedures**



- 1. Following an accident, the injured child will be directed to a trained First Aider.
- 2. The First Aider will speak to the child, investigate the injury, and decide what treatment is needed.
- 3. The First Aider will complete an accident report on CPOMs including details about how and where the injury occurred, and the treatment provided.
- 4. If a head injury is involved, then the child will have a pink wristband put around their wrist and a T2P text will be sent.
- 5. The First Aider will speak to the class teacher to inform them about the injury and the treatment provided.
- 6. At the end of the day, the class teacher will speak to the parent/guardian, to communicate information about the injury and treatment.
- 7. If the class teacher is unable to speak to the parent/guardian, then a teachers2parents text will be sent to inform the parent/guardian.
- 8. If the parent/guardian does not have a text number then the class teacher will phone the parent/guardian directly.
