Key Enquiry Questions:

What does a positive friendship look like?

A positive friendship is supporting one another, celebrating success, being kind, and feeling comfortable in their company.

How do I recognise online risks?

It is important to be aware of possible threats online and tell an adult about those threats.

When, where and who should I seek support from?

It is important to seek support from a known adult about online safety and risk.

How can I respect similarities/differences?

It is important to understand that we all have differences and similarities and be respectful towards anyone that is different or similar to you.

Key Vocabulary:

Concerns	When a person cares or shows worry
Harassment	Aggressive pressure or intimidation
Bullying	Seek to harm, intimidate or coerce
Online and in-person relationships	Having a friendship through the internet and friendships in others places such as school, home, and clubs.
Views	A manner of looking at or regarding something
Tradition	Handing down information from one generation to another.
Background	To describe where a person is from, what they do for a job/place of work, details of their experience
