How did the Anglo-Saxons arrive in the UK?

The Anglo-Saxons arrived firstly as warriors employed by the Roman army and then, two generations later, as settlers, to farm the land. They settled in the **eastern parts of Britain**, in what is today Kent, Sussex, Essex, and East Anglia.
