Consultation: Libraries and Museums Services

The Council is currently consulting on the future of Libraries and Museums Services in Cheshire West and Chester. A number of principles and proposals are being put forward about how the services are managed and when they open.

The Council wants to maintain consistent access to public libraries and museums at times residents want to use them and are proposing some changes to opening hours to enable this. The proposed changes have been designed using usage data and local knowledge to ensure that excellent services continue to be available to residents.

There will be several ways people can take part and share their views:

- Consultation documents and a survey are available online
- A paper version of the consultation documents and survey will be available at all Cheshire West libraries and museums.

When is the consultation?

5th February 2024 to 2nd April 2024.

How can I share my views?

The Council wants to understand the views of service users, residents, and stakeholders on the principles and proposals for the libraries and museums services. What you tell us will be used to help shape future plans.
