# **School Timings**

Please may I remind all concerned that the following school timings apply below:

Please can I remind all parents and carers of the timings above, we seem to have a number of groups together on the yard, we would advise everyone to drop off their child/children as quick as possible and to exit the school as per the one way system.

#### One way system:

We still have the one way system in place, please can we ask all parents/carers to adhere to this as it prevents a cross over of parents/carers and children at busy times. Just a reminder - the gate closest to Kiddicare Nursery is only for entry to the site and not exit and the path closest to the minibus/ empty building is solely for exit off the site. The ramp closest to the Verdin Exchange car park can be used to enter and exit the site and please don't forget that the gate on the old High Street is also open for any parents/carers wishing to use it.

# **Covid Restrictions:**

The advice from the Local Authority is that if your child has Covid symptoms they are to continue to get a PCR test. If a member of the household tests positive, but the child doesn't, then your child can come to school as normal, unless they display symptoms.

# New to Reception 2022-23

Please can I remind all parents if you have a child due to start school in September 2022 that you have until **15<sup>th</sup> January 2022** to apply online. If your child attends our nursery it does not mean you automatically obtain a place in Reception class, so please be sure to apply before the deadline to maximise your chances of obtaining a place.
