Covid Restrictions and illness:

Just a reminder, the advice from the Local Authority is that if your child has Covid symptoms they are to get a PCR test. If a member of the household tests positive, but the child doesn't, then your child can come to school as normal, unless they display symptoms.

In addition to this, please can I remind you that any child who has been sick or who has diarrhoea must not come back to school until they are clear of symptoms for 48 hours. This assists us in keeping the spread of this to a minimum. Thank you for your support with this matter.

Dear Parent / Carer

I am writing to inform you that our school is to participate in a Police-led initiative called Operation Encompass, a scheme which will ensure that we can better support any child where a domestic incident has been reported to Police from their home.

Following a domestic incident, the Police will make contact with the school via telephone and communicate relevant information to nominated, fully trained school staff. This will ensure that we are made aware early enough to support children and young people in a way that means they feel safe, supported and listen to.

Each school has a member of staff called a key adult who is trained to liaise with the police, when required, whilst ensuring support is available to the child.

The initiative has already been trialled & is now live in our schools across the local authority areas of Halton, Warrington, Cheshire West & Chester and Cheshire East with success. You can find out more about Operation Encompass via the following site: http://www.operationencompass.org/
