We will continue to consider how we could offer such a provision if we are invited to join a similar scheme in the future.

In the meantime, we will continue to offer our current breakfast club provision.

Earth Day

This will be a fun day where students can wear green to show their support for the environment. This event comes as we are launching our Sustainability Committee, and we are eager to host more exciting eco-friendly events in the future. Data System

Please bear with us for a few days after our return as the transfer may take a little time. Until then, you can continue to use the current School Gateway system. Attendance Reminder – School starts at 8.45am

Any child who arrives after the gates are closed must enter the school by the main entrance and report to the school office to sign in. If pupils are not in class when the register is taken, they will be

coded as 'L'. Any late arrivals after 9.15am will be coded as 'U' which is an unauthorised absence for that session.

Children who are consistently late for school are disrupting not only their own education, but also that of other children. Where persistent lateness gives cause for concern, you will be invited to a meeting to resolve the issues. If there is no improvement following this meeting, further action will be taken which may include referral to external agencies. You may approach the school at any time for support and advice if you are having difficulty getting your child to school on time or maintaining regular attendance.

<u>Hay fever</u>

We are now coming up to hay fever season. If your child suffers with hay fever and requires daily medication, please can you ensure that they have this before they come to school.
