

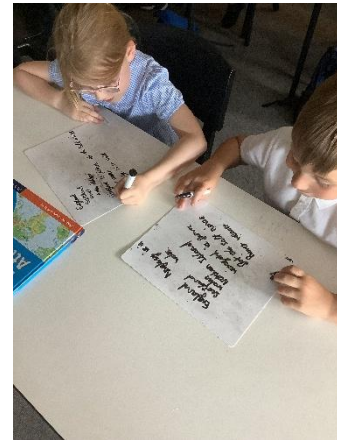


NEWSLETTER 28 - 3rd June 2025
