Winsford Library

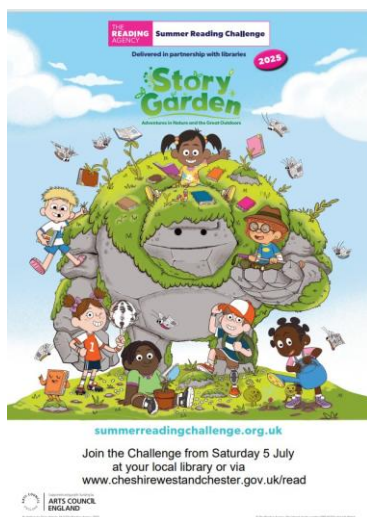
Please see message below from Ian Anstice at Winsford Library – sign up from **5th July**

I'm delighted to share with you details of the Summer Reading Challenge this year. Five thousand children from Cheshire West took part last year and we're hoping for more in 2025.

The Challenge (4- to 12-year-olds) and Mini Challenge (Under 4s) are entirely free. Children are given a sticker booklet for starting and stickers every time they read two books or whatever target they have set themselves. After reading their target of books (normally six), they are given a certificate and a medal. Any books qualify, from the library or not, and can be in print, digital, or audio form.



In addition, we have loads of free events, including favourites like animal handling and fun science but also face-painting and even Nick Sharratt (You Choose, Pants) will be visiting. Details of these events are on www.ticketsource.co.uk/cwaclibraries and will be bookable from 5 July. We also have special offers from partners such as Hayrack Church Farm (free child entry), Climbing Hut, and Deva Roman Experience just for joining, plus Brio have given us 200 family swim passes for the first children that come in to join. One child per library who completes each Challenge will receive a bug hotel/book (SRC) or a plush Gruffalo toy (Mini).



Children can join the Challenge from “Start Up Saturday” 5 July, at their local library or via <https://www.cheshirewestandchester.gov.uk/read> and can, from that date, book events for the first half of the holidays then all the rest of the events can be booked from Saturday 26 July.
