Key Vocabulary	Definition
5 Fingers 	1. Hinduism, 2. Hindu, 3. Vedas, 4. Sanskrit, 5. Temple / Mandir.
Brahman	The concept of God in Hinduism – infinite with no beginning and no end.
Aum 	Most sacred Hindu symbol – like calling God's name. Usually related to Shiva.
Trimurti	The three aspects of God in His forms as Brahma, Vishnu and Shiva. Also known as the Hindu Trinity.
Brahma	The Creator
Vishnu	The Preserver or Sustainer
Shiva	The Destroyer
Ganesha	Elephant-headed god. God of wisdom, success and good luck.
Ramayana	The story of Rama and Sita, celebrated during Diwali.
Diwali	Hindu festival of light.
