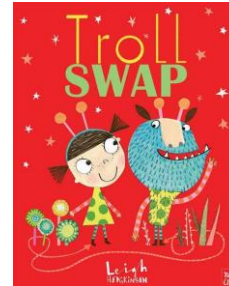


Homework Projects - Autumn Term (1)

This term our focus in Geography will be looking at significant places in Winsford and Hartington and how the two places are similar and different.

<p><u>Geography 1</u></p> <p>What do you like about living in our community? What places do you like to visit in Winsford and why? Write a sentence to explain.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you create a poster advertising Winsford to someone who might want to visit?</p>	<p><u>Geography 2</u></p> <p>Go on a walk around Winsford. Can you write a list of all the physical and human features you can find?</p> <p>Challenge: Create an information leaflet or poster explaining what you have found.</p>	<p><u>Art – Drawing</u></p> <p>Go on an autumn walk with your family or look for signs of autumn in your garden.</p> <p>Sketch some of the things you find.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you use your pencil to create light and dark tones in different areas?</p>
<p><u>English – Autumn Senses Writing</u></p> <p>Go on a walk and use your senses to help you describe what you can see, touch, hear and smell.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you use some adjectives to describe what you saw/touched/heard/smelt?</p>	<p><u>Science- Everyday Materials</u></p> <p>Can you find some objects around your home that are made from more than one material? Draw a picture and label what they are made from e.g. glass, plastic, metal, wood.</p> <p>Challenge: Can you describe and record some of the object's properties e.g. hard/soft, smooth/rough, bendy/stiff?</p>	<p><u>PSHE – Belonging</u></p> <p>Draw a picture of yourself and write some sentences about you.</p> <p>What are your favourite things and why do you like them? What are your favourite things about you as a person?</p>
<p><u>DT – Structures</u></p> <p>This term, our English texts feature trolls! Can you make a home for a troll using junk modelling? It could be a bridge (we know they traditionally like to reside under bridges!) or even a forest cave, like the troll who made a mess in our classrooms!</p> <p>Challenge: Can you create a little troll or find a toy that could be a troll to test your structure. Does your troll/toy fit well in the cave/home? If you've made a bridge, does it hold your troll/toy well?</p>		<p><u>English – Reading</u></p> <p>Visit your local library and pick some books that look fantastic.</p> <p>Read them on your own or with somebody else.</p> <p>Write a book review, telling us what you loved about the books you chose.</p> <p>Remember to include the title, the author and a star rating. Don't forget to log your reads in your reading diary!</p>
