•	Word list – years 5 and 6
•	Homophones and other words that are often confused
٠	Words containing the letter-string <i>ough</i>
٠	Verb prefixes: <i>dis-, mis-, de-, re-, over-</i>
٠	Words with the /i:/ sound spelt <i>ei</i> after <i>c</i>
•	Words with 'silent' letters (i.e. whose presence cannot be predicted from the pronunciation of the word)
•	Endings which sound like /ʃəs/ spelt - <i>cious</i> or - <i>tious</i>
•	Converting nouns or adjectives into verbs using suffixes: -ate, -ise, -ify
•	Words ending in -able/-ably and -ible/-ibly
٠	Endings which sound like /ʃəl/ (- <i>cial</i> and - <i>tial</i>)
•	Singular and plural possessive apostrophe
•	Adding suffixes beginning with vowel letters to words ending in -fer
•	Use of the hyphen
•	Words ending in -ant, -ance/-ancy
•	Words ending in -ent, -ence/-ency
