Key Word	Definition
Season	The seasons are four different times during the year with different types of weather.
Autumn	Autumn is the season when warm summer temperatures gradually decrease to the cold of winter
Winter	Winter is the coldest season of the year.
Weather	Weather is the way the air and the atmosphere feels
